## **Introduction**

*Big Wheel Racing* is an international multi-sport racing team. We participate in all types of international, national and local cycling events: mountain, road, cyclocross, triathlons, and adventure races. Team members participate in United States of America Cycling (USAC) races in all disciplines; 12-hr, 24-hr, and 100-mile endurance events, adventure races; and many similar races in Europe and Canada. Many members of *Big Wheel Racing* compete on single speed bicycles, in both off-road and road events.

Each year, *Big Wheel Racing* team members make a significant donation to World Bicycle Relief, which is generously matched by our bike shop sponsor, High Desert Bicycles.
